Event Information SWFL Paranormal & UFO Conference 2023 is a one day event taking place on Sunday, January 15 at the Snappers Laugh In Comedy Cafe, 8595 College Parkway #270. Fort Myers, FL 33919. This event will be open to the public, with a charged admission fee. The vendor hall hours are 10-6pm.

Table set up

All exhibitors should be set up by 10am. Anyone who sells through their product may leave early, but will be required to leave business cards or promotional literature at each of their tables. Table space should be cleaned prior to leaving. Load In Hours: Sat 7:30am – 9:45am. Exhibitors not checked in by **9:45am** will lose their table space. Any guest exhibitors running late for any reason should contact us as soon as possible to inform us of the situation.

Outdoor Vendors

For this event there will be a small handful of special guest tables inside and a limited amount of guest tables and vendors outside.

No electrical access

We apologize for the inconvenience, however there will not be electrical access for vendors at this venue. Please be sure to bring your battery back up cell phone charger and any other battery operated products that you may need.

Artist and Vendor Badge Rules

All Staff working a table, a vendor's family or otherwise, are required to have a badge. Additional badges other than those included with a purchase of tables are \$15 each. Exhibitors should wear and keep their badges visible throughout the show to help all staff distinguish them from guests. All “guests” of artist and vendors coming into the show, whether doing business or not; be they visiting family, customers who have prepurchased and are picking up items, etc., must pay admission to be admitted into the show.

No Outside Food or Drinks Allowed

Per the venue guidelines at this venue, please no outside food or drinks are allowed inside the venue.

No burning incense, candles, or open flame

Theft of Exhibitor Property

Writer, Artist, Vendor & Exhibitor Rules and Guidelines

Guests exhibitors and any of their staff/helpers are expected to be respectful and courteous to others, including attendees, venue staff, event staff, ect. All materials must be original or licensed properly; bootleg or pirated materials are not allowed. Facepainting must be preapproved and any facepaint used must be non-allergenic. Any facepainters assume 100% responsibility & liability for any claims arising from the facepainting services. Any oils & products used on attendees must be non allergenic. Vendor assumes responsibility for any harm caused by their products at the event. Materials rated Mature need to be out of reach from children, with no obscene graphics or nudity/partial nudity visible. *Writers, Artist and Vendors are required to follow general guidelines: no real weapons, no realistic toy guns; no bare feet, no skates, hover boards or skateboards inside the convention center/ hotel unless it is part of a preapproved showing, no play fighting unless it is part of a preapproved showing *Please refrain from using foul language. This will be a family event -loud excessive foul language(IE - yelling obscenities) will not be tolerated.

Taxes It is the vendor's responsibility to report sales revenue and pay taxes as applicable by state, and federal regulations.

Violation of Event Rules

Nexus9 reserves the right to strictly enforce the event rules. Anyone who is determined to be in violation of these rules by Nexus9 or who creates a hostile situation with others will be, at Nexus9's discretion, removed from the show and may be barred from exhibiting at future Nexus9 events. Exhibitors instructed to leave must immediately vacate the host facility premises. Exhibitors refusing to comply will have their materials removed at their expense, and will bear all risk of damage associated with the movement of their materials. No exhibitor who is removed from the show for any reason will be entitled to any refund of any fees, or any monetary damages.
